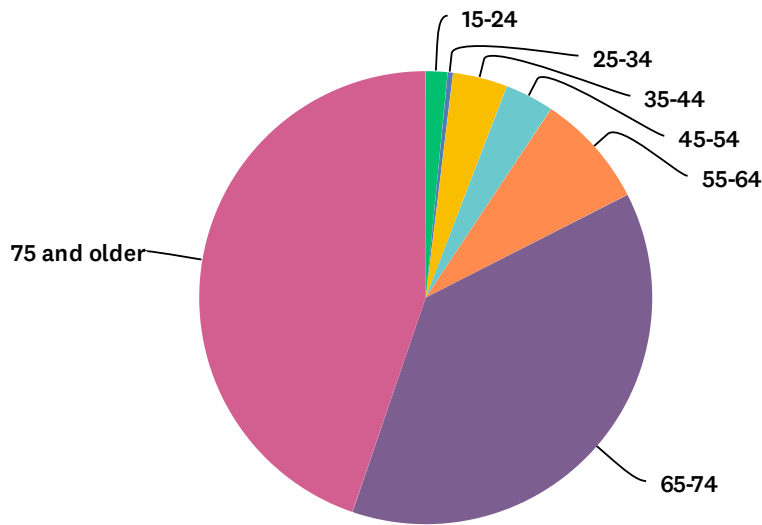

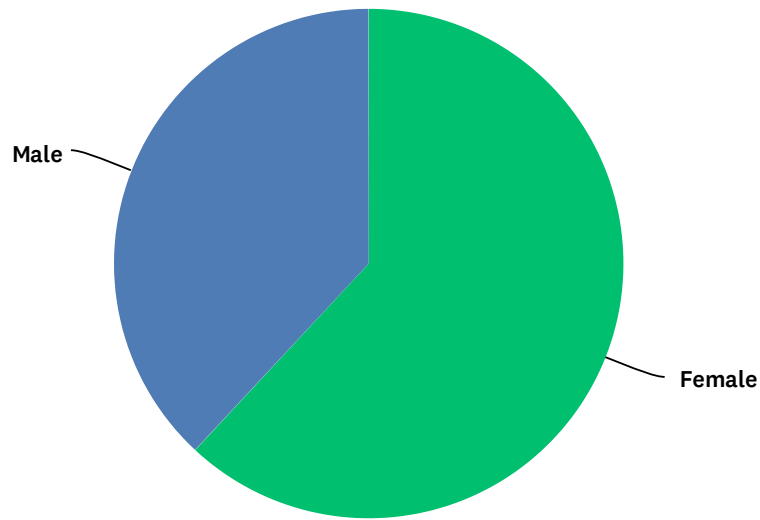

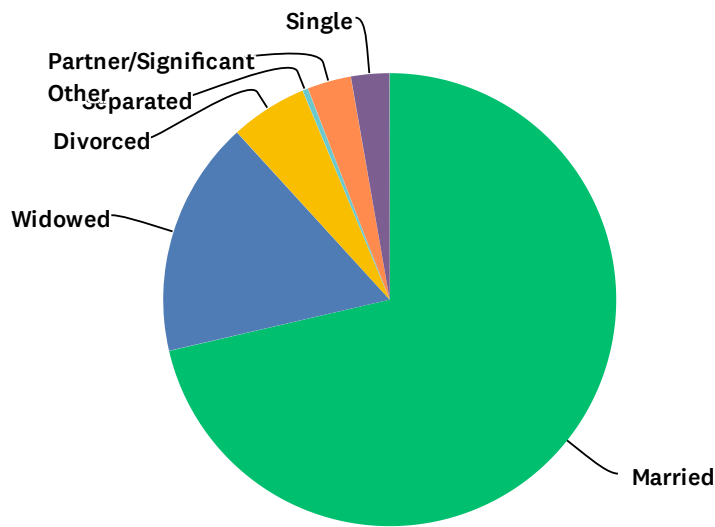

Q3 Which of the following best describes your current relationship status?

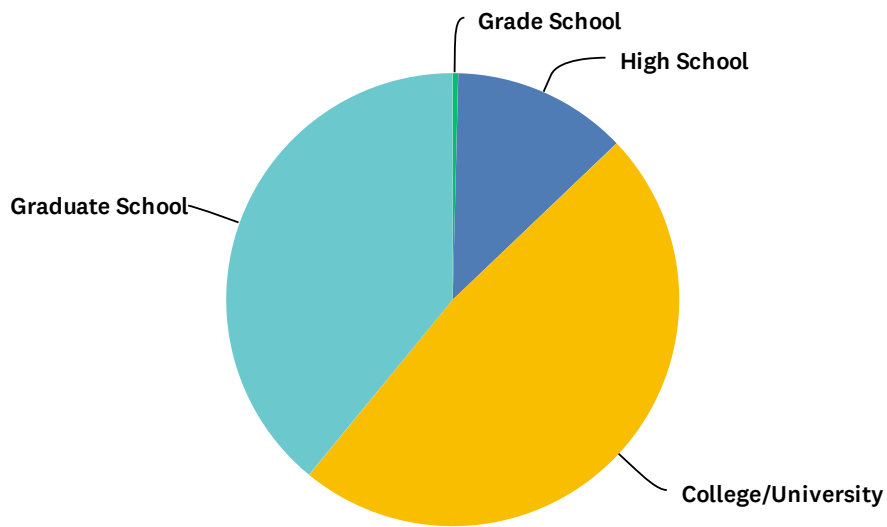

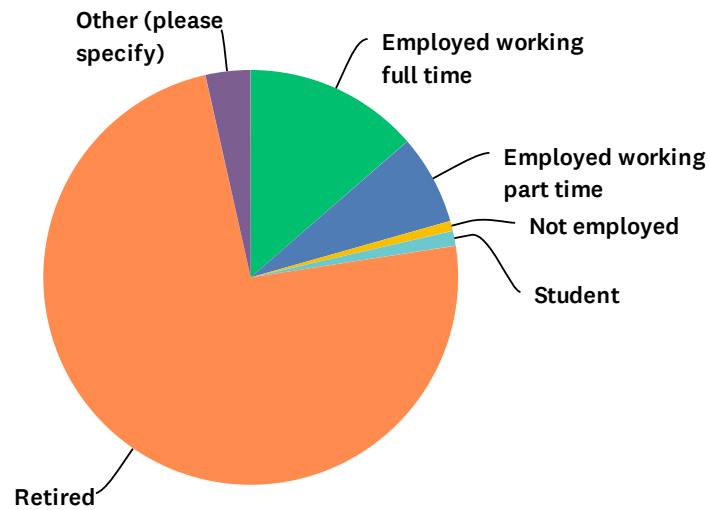

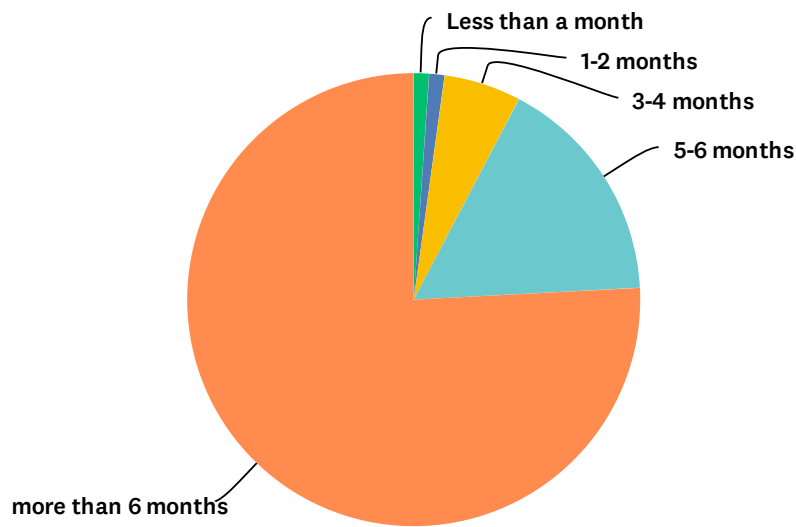

Q7 If no, how much time do you spend in the Venice area?

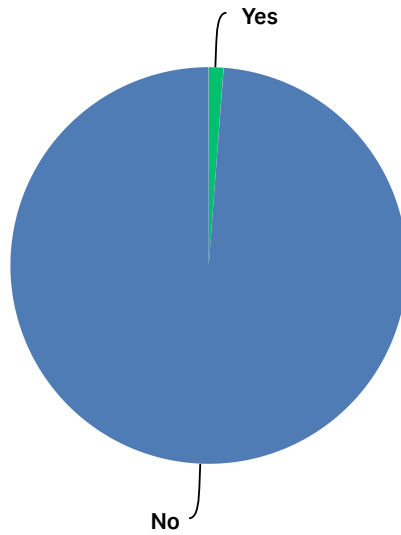

Q8 Do you plan to move out of the general area or stop visiting Venice in the next two to four years?

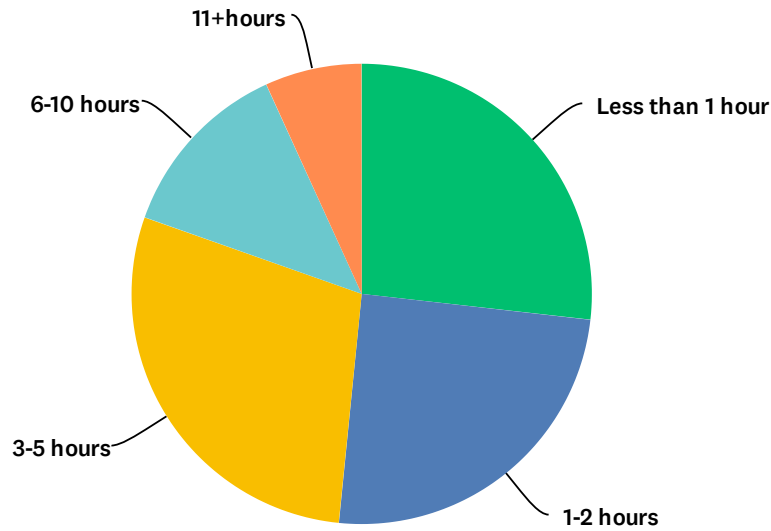

Q9 How many hours per week on average do you spend in volunteer community activities, clubs or organizations other than church (for the time that you spend in Venice)?

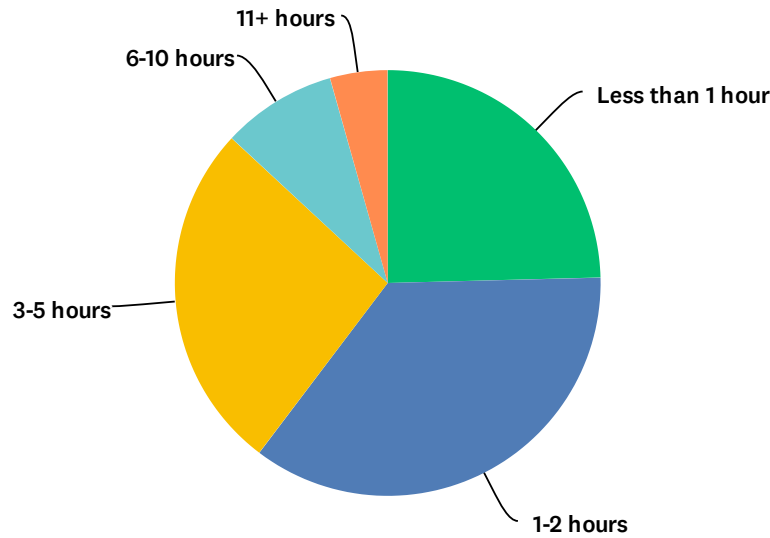

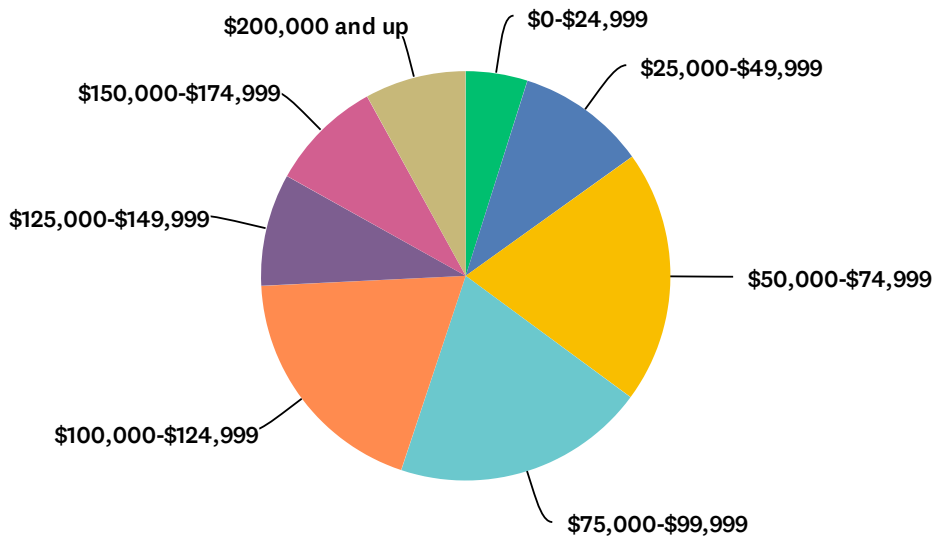

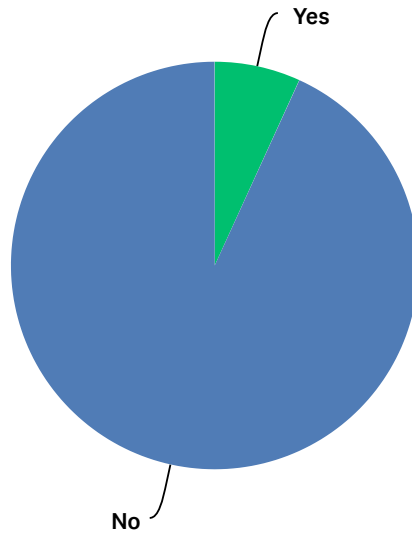

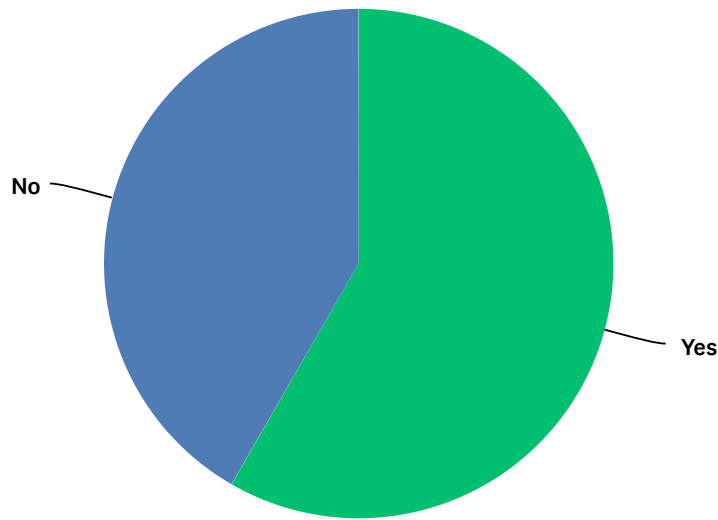

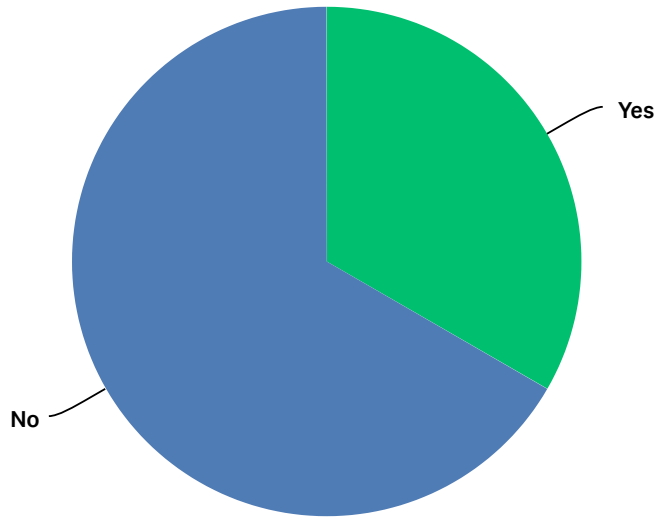

Q15 Do they participate in Saint Mark's youth activities (including Sunday School and/or Youth Programs?)

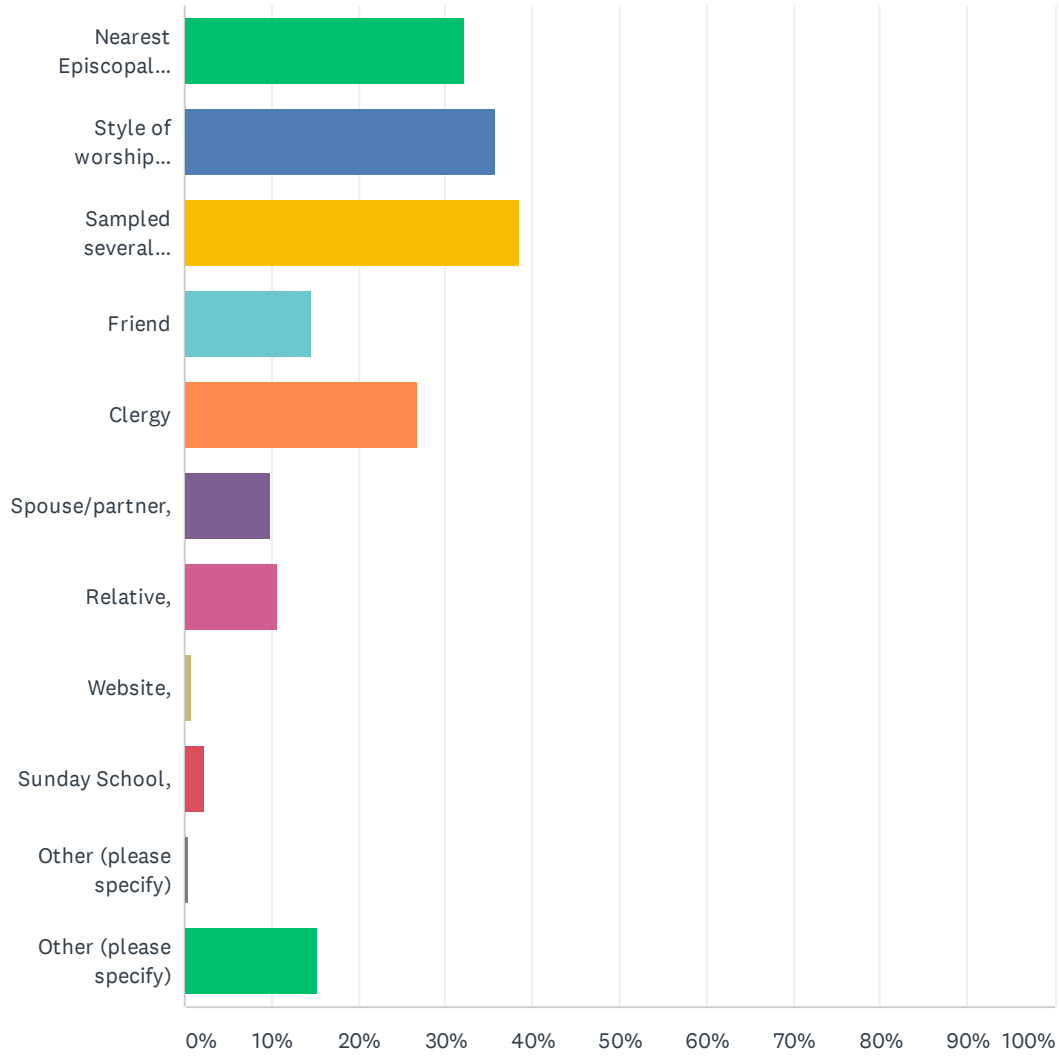

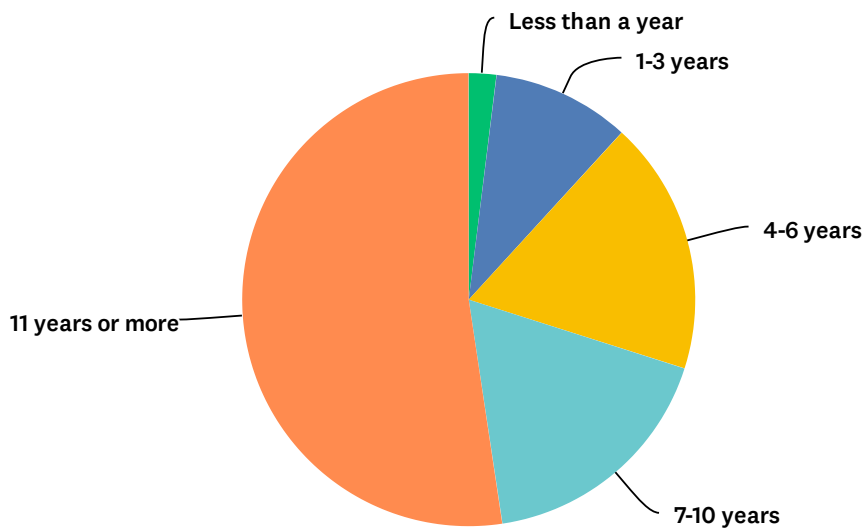

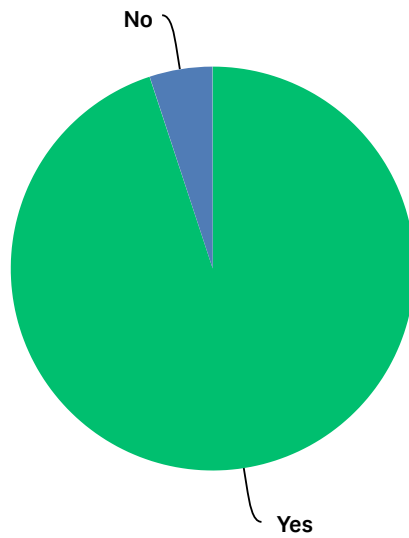

Q20 Do you consider yourself a member of Saint Marks?

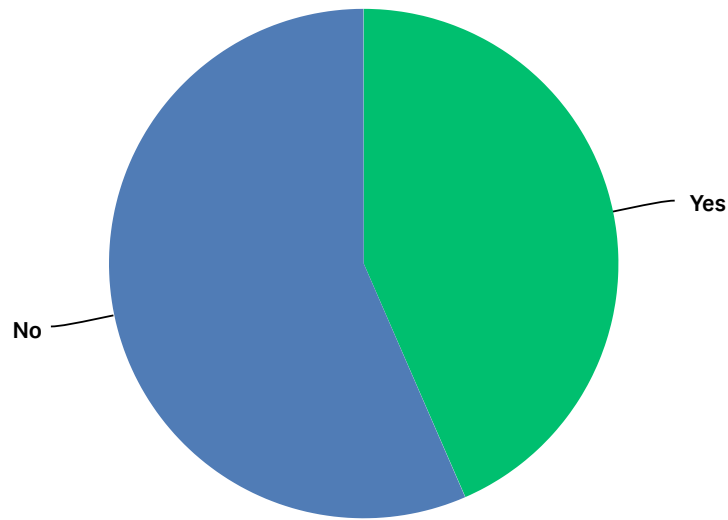

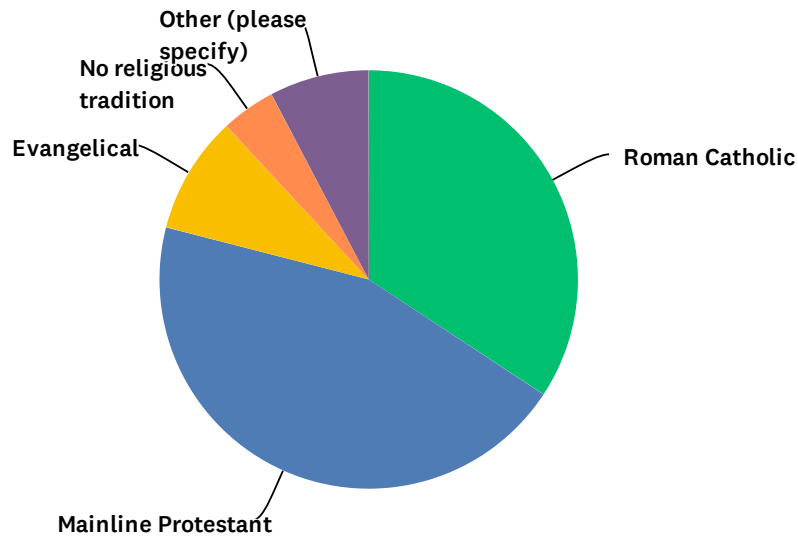

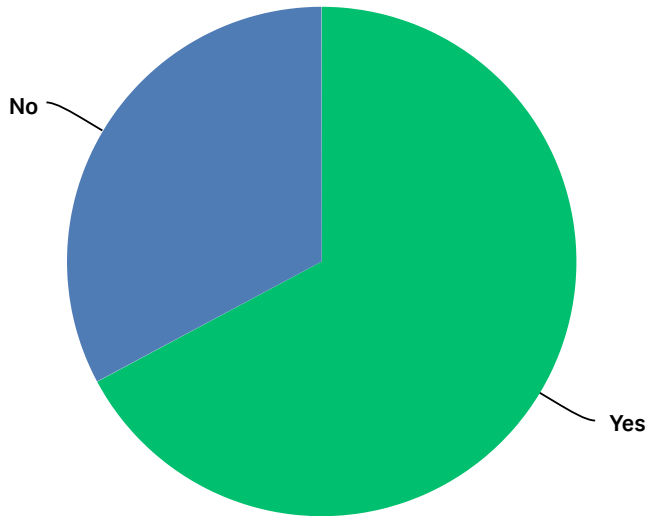
